The top 420 team (overall scores are the teams A and B division boats combined) will get a berth to the Lawrence A White Trophy regatta. The top 6 420 teams (overall scores) will get a berth to the GL championship. Each high school must designate in advance to the regatta chair which team (one per high school) will be attempting to qualify for the GL Championship and the Lawrence A White Trophy regatta. The team's that earn Qualifying Spots have till Tuesday September 15th at noon CST to declare their intent to compete to the Regatta Chair, Area Rep and MISSA President. High schools may have more than one 420 team participate in the Kick-Off Classic if spots are available.
