Rules: The regatta will be governed by the 2013-2016 ISAF RRS, the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association, the ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA Procedural Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility: This is a Tier 3 regatta. Competing schools must be members of ISSA/MISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the procedural rules. Students in grades 7-12 are eligible to compete. A team is comprised of no fewer than four and no more than six, who are full time students. Mixed teams and multiple teams per school will be allowed.

<u>Each school may enter up to two teams on a first come first serve basis</u>. Requests to enter a third team will be accepted in the same time priority order as an eligible school's original entry. The decision to accept a third team entry from an eligible school is at the sole discretion of the organizing authority.

Registration and Entry: Each competitor must register online at: https://2016artjohnsoninvitational.eventbrite.com

<u>Entries must be received by 5:00pm Monday, October 12th.</u> A team that withdraws from the regatta after the entry deadline or fails to compete at the event shall forfeit its entry fees. <u>Coaches must email their team rosters to sailwbss@gmail.com</u> before the entry deadline.

Fees: The entry fee is \$45.00 per competitor. This includes two breakfasts and two lunches for competitors and coaches. Additional meal packages available for \$10 per day.

A refundable damage deposit of \$200/team must be submitted no later than 8:45am on Saturday, October 17. <u>Damage deposit checks should be made payable to "WBSS"</u>. In the event that damage to a boat is not attributed to one team, the expense of the repair will be allocated evenly among all the teams competing.
