AMENDMENT: 7. Entry and Communication; 8. Boats; 13. Food and Beverages

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1. RULES

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the MISSA Procedural Rules, the Notice of Race and these sailing instructions..

2. SCHEDULE

Saturday, October 15th

8:00-9:00am Breakfast provided in PYC

9:15am - Competitor's Meeting on Patio – coaches meeting to immediately follow

9:45am – First Warning. Sailing will continue throughout the day. No Lunch break – sailors should eat between rotations. Lunch included

5:00pm – No races will be started after 5pm

Sunday, October 16th

9:30am – First Warning. Sailing will continue throughout the day. No Lunch break – sailors should eat between rotations. Lunch included

2pm – No races will be started after 2:30pm

Awards Presentation – to follow racing

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Any changes to these Sailing Instructions will be posted no later than 30 minutes before the first warning signal of the day, on the official Notice Board located on the window nearest the registration table

4. SAFETY

4.1 USCG Approved Type III PFD's are to be worn at all times – shore to shore. Anyone not wearing a USCG Approved PFD will be protested by the Race Committee.

5. COURSES

5.1 Race time may exceed 20 minutes due to number of participants, thus changing ISSA Procedural Rule 7.7(b)

5.2 The courses the Race Committee will be using are Windward/Leeward format. W3 and W5 will be used to signify upwind finishes, 3 and 5 legs total. L2 and L4 will be used to signify downwind finishes, 2 and 4 legs total. Courses will be modified with Start/Finish line in the middle.

5.3 All Marks will be large bright orange inflatable buoys.

5.4 Starting sequence shall be 3-minute dinghy starts per RRS appendix S.

6. INDIVIDUAL/GENERAL RECALLS

6.1 Code Flax "X" may be displayed for individual recalls. It is the responsibility of the yacht to make a proper start. Failure of the Race Committee to make these signals or failure of a starter on the course side or to see or hear these signals shall not relieve the offending yacht from restarting and is not grounds for redress.

7. Entry and Communication

7.1 Team leaders of eligible schools must email a roster of each team they intend to bring to the event—including sailor name, school, and graduation year—to Kelly Monahan prior to **October 14, 2016**.

7.2 Each team shall turn in a Damage Deposit for \$250.00 at check-in on the first day of racing. Checks should be made out to MYST.

7.3 A team is only registered upon confirmation that their team roster has been received. Team leaders will receive confirmation of their registration based on these requirements. Eventbrite for the event will close at 8:00pm on October 7. All unpaid sailors must bring checks or cash for registration to the event.

8. BOATS

8.1 All competitors will use C420s. PLSS/MYST have a limited number of boats for use during the event. Nearby teams will likely need to supply a 420 for each team they bring. Team leaders must request a 420 for their team to use by emailing Kelly Monahan (sailplss@gmail.com).

8.2 Coaches for the event will be expected to bring a power boat capable of rotating their sailors on the water.

9. PROTESTS

9.1 Protest procedure will be using 3 minute justice system

9.2 Protests must be filed no later than 30 minutes after the RC signal boat has docked. Dock time will be posted on the official notice board.

10. SCORING

10.1 Scoring will be prescribed by the ISSA Procedural Rules 9

10.2 All completed races shall be counted; there will be no throw-outs.

10.3 A minimum of one race in each division is required for a regatta to be official

11. COACHING

11.1 All coaches shall be registered in accordance with MISSA By-Laws, Article III C, Section 3 “Registration – Coaches” and must be on the team roster prior to October 14, 2016.

11.2 Coaches may go afloat in the starting area so long as they stay a minimum of 100 yards from the racing area at all times and not communicate with participants at any time during the racing.

11.3 It is the responsibility of the coaches to withdraw their competitors should the conditions exceed the limitations of any sailor.

12. Housing

12.1 Housing is provided on a first come-first serve basis, please contact our housing coordinator: Sarah Spencer
