1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the MISSA Procedural Rules, the Notice of Race and these sailing instructions.
- 1.2 In accordance with Rule 70.5(a) and ISSA PR 20, decisions of the protest committee are final.
- 1.3 This is a MISSA Tier 2 Event.

2. SCHEDULE

Saturday, September 17th

8:00-9:00am REGISTRATION/CHECK IN Breakfast provided in PYC 9:15am - Competitor's Meeting on Patio – coaches meeting to immediately follow Competitor's Meeting.

9:45am – First Warning. Sailing will continue throughout the day. No Lunch break – sailors should eat between rotations. Lunch included 5:00pm – No races will be started after 5pm

Sunday, September 18th

9:30am – First Warning. Sailing will continue throughout the day. No Lunch break – sailors should eat between rotations. Lunch included 2pm – No races will be started after 2:30pm Awards Presentation – to follow racing

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Any changes to these Sailing Instructions will be posted no later than 30 minutes before the first warning signal of the day, on the official Notice Board located on the window nearest the registration table

4. SAFETY

4.1 USCG Approved Type III PFD's are to be worn at all times – shore to shore. Anyone not wearing a USCG Approved PFD will be protested by the Race Committee.

5. COURSES

- 5.1 Race time may exceed 20 minutes due to number of participants, thus changing ISSA Procedural Rule 7.7(b)
- 5.2 The courses the Race Committee will be using are Modified Windward/Leeward format. W2 and W4 will be used to signify upwind finishes, 3 and 5 legs total. L2 and L4 will be used to signify Downwind finishes, 4 and 6 legs total. Courses will be modified with Start/Finish line in the middle.
- 5.3 All Marks will be large bright orange inflatable buoys.

6. INDIVIDUAL/GENERAL RECALLS

6.1 Code Flax "X" may be displayed for individual recalls. It is the responsibility of the yacht to make a proper start. Failure of the Race Committee to make these signals or failure of a starter on the course side or to see or hear these signals shall not relieve the offending yacht from restarting and is not grounds for redress.

7. BOATS

- 7.1 All competitors will be using PLSS/MYST provided C420's and MYST Sails.
- 7.2 PLSS has a limited number of boats available for competitors. Some teams may be asked to provide boats for the rotation.

8. PROTESTS

- 8.1 Protest procedure will be using 3 minute justice system
- 8.2 Protests must be filed no later than 30 minutes after the RC signal boat has docked. Dock time will be posted on the official notice board.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 Scoring will be prescribed by the ISSA Procedural Rules 9
- 9.2 All completed races shall be counted; there will be no throw-outs.
- 9.3 A minimum of one race in each division is required for a regatta to be official
- 9.4 This regatta is the Great Lakes Qualifier for MISSA West schools. One team per school is will be accepted by the registration deadline. Second teams from a school may be placed on a waitlist and if the regatta is not full at the entry deadline, may be accepted in the order they were placed on the waitlist. The Top 5 West teams will qualify for the Great Lakes Championship regatta, the team finishing first will also qualify for ACC. Berths must be accepted in accordance with MISSA District Rule 5.11 or they will by offered to the next team in line by the MISSA President.

10.COACHING

- 10.1 All coaches shall be registered in accordance with MISSA By-Laws, Article III C, Section 3 "Registration Coaches" and must be on the team roster prior to September 16, 2017.
- 10.2 Coaches may go afloat in the starting area so long as they stay a minimum of 100 yards from the racing area at all times and not communicate with participants at any time during the racing.
- 10.3 It is the responsibility of the coaches to withdraw their competitors should the conditions exceed the limitations of any sailor.

11.Registration

- 11.1 Register teams via email to Regatta Chair by September 8th.
- 11.2 Final Rosters are due to Regatta Chair September 11th
- 11.3 Registration Fee \$45/sailor is due at Check In Saturday morning. Damage deposit is \$250/team.
