## **NOTICE OF RACE**

## 1. RULES

1.1. This is a MISSA Tier 3 Regatta and will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020, ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA By-laws, District rules, this notice of race and the sailing instructions.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 2.1. All High School Varsity and Junior Varsity teams are welcome. Competitors must be grades 7-12. Membership in MISSA and ISSA is required. This event will be run in conjunction with the Junior Olympic Sailing Festival – Macatawa.
- 2.2. Teams comprised of members from multiple schools are eligible. HOWEVER- It is the responsibility of coaches and advisors to organize and register those teams.
- 2.3. Scoring will be in TechScore and you must be active in the system.
- 2.4. Eligible schools and sailors register on Regatta Network https://www.regattanetwork.com/clubmgmt/applet\_registration\_form.php?regatta\_id=17404
- 2.5. The entry deadline is Friday, October 5th, 2018. No late registrations accepted.
- 2.6. The regatta will consist of single divisions of 420's (no traps, mainsheet bridles or spinnakers). A full team shall be comprised of maximum of 4 sailors per boat (alternates optional) for the division.

### 3. FEES

The entry fee is \$50 per competitor and includes continental breakfast, lunch and pizza after racing on Saturday and Sunday breakfast and lunch for all sailors and one coach.

### 4. BOATS

- 4.1 MBJA will provide 13 420's for the fleet. If we need more we will ask you to bring boats.
- 4.2 Registration is limited to the first 13 teams. Additional teams may be added based on availability of borrowed 420's.
