RULES: The Regatta will be governed by the 2018-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of US Sailing, ISAF RRS, the Procedural Rules of the Interscholastic Sailing Association, this notice of race, the sailing instructions, MISSA By-laws and District rules.

DATE: Saturday October 6th

ELIGIBILITY: This regatta is the Spring Chill Fleet Regatta, Tier 3. Mixed teams are welcome. We have 18, 420s available. Membership in MISSA is required.

FORMAT: The regatta will consist of A and B divisions of 420s (no traps, spinnakers or mainsheet bridles). Round Robin format and one race constitutes a regatta.

- First warning 9:15 am, races will continue throughout the day
- Lunch will be provided on dock between rotations

ENTRY FEE: \$30.00 per sailor.
