

Qualifying Conditions as Stated During Registration

“Competing schools must be members of ISSA and MISSA. This is a Tier 2 fleet race regatta. This event is open to MISSA area high schools only. **Schools may enter multiple teams provided that every school that desires to enter a team is able and if there are boats remaining for a school to have more than one team. Schools desiring more than one team will be granted the additional team in order in which they contact the regatta chairperson at gc@uznis.com. If a school has more than one team, they will assign one team 1 (the team competing to qualify for the Nationals berth) and team 2 (the team sailing for experience).**

This Tier 2 regatta shall serve as the qualifier for the PCISA Girls National Championship. The event is being hosted by Grosse Pointe South High School on September 14-15, 2019 at Grosse Pointe Yacht Club in Grosse Pointe Shores, Michigan.

The top placing teams will qualify to go to the PCISA Girls Invitational October 19-20, 2019 at San Diego Yacht Club in San Diego, California.”

It has been determined that **4 berths** have been granted an invitation to the PCISA Girls Invitational. At the completion of the regatta, 1st through 4th place teams should email Lynn Frikker, Ted Anderson, and Mike Segerblom by 12 noon on Tues Sept 17 to state if they will take a berth at the PCISA Girls Invitational. And also by that date register and pay for the PCISA Girls Invitational. If a team is unable, the next placing team will be offered the berth and declare their intentions.
