SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES:

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in:

1.1.1. The Racing Rules of Sailing

1.1.2. The Official Procedural Rules for Interscholastic Sailing Competition published by the Interscholastic Sailing Association ("ISSA") as modified by this NOR; and

1.1.3. The Midwest Interscholastic Sailing Association ("MISSA") Supplemental Rules

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS:

2.1. The online official notice board will be located under "Notice Board" on the MISSA Girls Qualifier page at <http://scores.hssailing.org>.

3 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

3.1. Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted no later than 09:00CDT on the day it will take effect. However, the sailing instructions may be modified on the water without such notice pursuant to Section 3.2, below.

3.2. SI's amended on the water shall be signaled with a third substitute and a sound signal, after which race committee will notify all teams verbally.

4 BOATS:

4.1. Club 420s will be provided by the Lake Minnetonka Sailing School.

4.2. Boats will be sailed as provided. No modifications will be permitted to the running rigging.

5 SCHEDULE:

SATURDAY, 9/25

08:00-10:00 CDT Shuttles between Lighthouse Island and Park Avenue. Rigging immediately upon arrival

09:15 CDT Competitors and coaches meeting

10:00 CDT First warning

SUNDAY, 9/26

08:00-10:00 CDT Shuttles between Lighthouse Island and Park Avenue. Rigging immediately upon arrival

15:00 CDT No warning signal will be made after this time

6 RACING AREA:

6.1. All races will be sailed in close proximity to the Lake Minnetonka Sailing School (Lighthouse Island).

7 COURSES:

7.1. Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses the length of the course as described in ISSAPR 7.

8 FORMAT:

8.1. The planned format is a single round robin.

9 MARKS:

9.1. The windward mark and the leeward gate marks will be red inflated triangles. All other marks of the course excluding the start and finish boats will be round orange buoys.

10 THE START:

10.1. The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee signal boat and the course side of the port-end starting mark.

11 THE FINISH:

12.1. The finishing line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee finish boat and the course side of the port-end finishing mark.

12 COACHING:

13.1. All coaching will be from shore unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chairperson.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:

14.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
