NOTICE OF RACE

2021-2022 SAISA COVID Points Regatta Protocols

- **Boats will not be rotated.**
- **It is critical to be mindful of how you feel, and, particularly when ANY of the potential COVID-19 symptoms are present, to please stay home.**

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the SAISA Supplemental Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. In the event of a conflict between the governing documents and the Sailing Instructions the latter shall take precedence.
- 1.2. RRS Appendix P is in effect modified per ISSA Procedural Rule 14(c).

2. ELIGIBILITY and FORMAT:

- 2.1. Competing schools must be current members of ISSA and SAISA and meet eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules, and Supplemental Rules.
- 2.2. Registration is on a first paid and registered /first allowed basis to ISSA and SAISA member schools only. Once 12 schools have registered, each school team will be notified by the venue that their entry shall be contingent upon their ability to bring their own 420 sailboat to add to the rotation. Registration will be confirmed via email, or phone, if email is not available.
- 2.3. Composite teams and Junior Varsity teams will be permitted to register however will not be allocated a boat until all varsity teams have received allocation. There is a slight chance if we don't have enough troop transport teams we will limit the JV/Composite teams.
- 2.4. Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school. The team leader must have the authority to authorize medical care for all sailors on their team.
- 2.5. This will be a two-division regatta. Teams will be randomly assigned a boat at the skippers meeting. A and B division will rotate in the teams assigned boat for the entire day. No boat rotations will occur.

3. REGISTRATION /DAMAGE DEPOSIT /WAIVERS AND COMMUNICATIONS:

- 3.1. Registration Fee is \$60 per school. Registration and Payment must be made by mailing the registration form and check to the address below. Eligible schools and sailors must register by Monday November 29th @ 8:00pm. Please call, text or email Carrie Rohde or Debbie Tillman and let us know your intentions.
- 3.2. Damage Deposit is \$100 per school and must be paid with each registration (**separate checks please to GCWSC**). This is refundable if the boat and the gear are returned undamaged. In the event damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly amongst all the competing teams.
- 3.3. All waivers must be turned in no later than "check in" Please note we will not accept EMAILED waivers the day of or after the event.

4. LUNCH:

Lunches will be available for purchase at \$10 and include a pulled pork sandwich, mac and cheese, cookie and water. Please send lunch order and separate check with registration. Lunch orders will only be available with registration. Extra water will not be available on sight so please bring ample water for you team. Please make lunch order checks out to **RH Sailing Boosters**.

5. BOATS:

- 5.1 The host will provide 12 - 420 Sailboats and sails.
- 5.2 Boats will be allocated on a first registered and paid basis. After the total number of provided boats has been allocated, registering teams will be required to provide a boat of **comparable condition** to be entered into the regatta.

6. SCHEDULE:

- 6.1 Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board located at check in table.

7. RACING AREA:

- 7.1. All races will be on the Medway River adjacent to the public Ramp in Sunbury, GA.

8. COURSES:

- 8.1. Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSA PR 7.7.

9. SCORING:

- 9.1. The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

10. HOUSING:

10.1. Housing is not provided.

11. TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION:

Sunbury public ramp - From South bound 95 get off at exit 76. At top of ramp make a Left onto US84/GA38 Colonels Island Rd. Travel 4.5 miles and turn Left onto Fort Morris Rd. (you will see signs for Sunbury Crab Co. and Fort Morris on the corner). Travel approx. 3.5 miles down Fort Morris Rd. Shortly after you pass Fort Morris on your right you will come to a fork in the road with a yellow sign go right at the fork and follow to the water. You will see the boats on your right and the ramp in front of you.

From North bound 95 – get off at exit 76 and make a right at the top of the ramp. Follow the directions above.

12. COACHING:

- 12.1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area during racing on Saturday, 4 December 2021 unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chairperson. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

13. OFFICIAL NOTICE:

- 13.1. No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, marijuana or any other controlled substance, as defined in 21 U.S. Code 802, the possession of which is unlawful under U.S. Code 841, or alcoholic beverages (distilled spirits, wine, and beer, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use). An alleged breach of this procedural rule shall not be grounds for a protest. However, when a report is received from any source, alleging such a breach a protest committee consisting of the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA Board of Directors, and the chairperson of the protest committee, shall follow the process described in RRS 69.1(b). If a hearing under RRS 69 is held, a competitor found to have breached this procedural rule shall be excluded from the remaining races of the series and, where practical, be removed from the regatta venues and sent home. Additional penalties consistent with RRS 69.2 may be imposed on the competitor or the competitor's team. This regulation is in effect during the entire event from the date and time of arrival through the date and time of departure from the regatta site.

14. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS:

- 14.1. By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

15. WAIVER OF LIABILITY:

- 15.1. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
- 15.2. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By

participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
