## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **1. RULES:**

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and will be run in accordance with the Interscholastic Sailing Association Procedural Rules, MISSA District Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 In accordance with Rule 70.5(2) and ISSA PR 20, decisions of the protest committee are final. US Sailing's permission has been granted.

### **2. ELIGIBILITY:**

2.1 Competing teams must be members of MISSA in good standing. A "Team" shall be made up of a minimum of 4 sailors, between the grades of 7-12. This is a Tier 3 event. Mixed teams (comprised of students from different schools) WILL be allowed.

2.2 The regatta is limited to (24) teams and entries are accepted on a time priority basis (first come, first served") Entries received in excess of twenty-four team limit will be recorded on a waiting list. If the number of teams entered falls below the 24-team limit prior to the entry deadline, entry will be offered to teams on the waiting list in priority order.

2.3 Eligible schools may not enter more than 2 teams.

2.4 A JV level regatta may be run simultaneously.

### **3. BOATS:**

3.1 Club 420s/420E boats shall be sailed as provided by The Foundry. Class rules shall not apply.

3.2 Boats will be checked in and out upon launch and haul out. Any previously existing damage should be reported upon launching. Any new damage should be reported between races or upon haul out. All damage is the responsibility of the team(s) sailing the boat.

3.3 No changes or modifications to rigging or boats are permitted without the permission of the Regatta Chair. Teams violating this rule may be disqualified from the regatta.

### **4. REGATTA FORMAT:**

4.1 This will be a two-division regatta with rotations.

### **5. ENTRY:**

5.1 The entry fee is \$20 per sailor. Breakfast and lunch will be available for registered teams and one coach.

5.2 Additional lunches for non-competitors may be purchased for \$5.

5.3 Registration deadline is 1700 September 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021

5.5 A damage deposit is required in the amount of \$200 per team. Checks should be made out to *the Cleveland Foundry* and brought to the event.

5.6 Foundry waivers for each sailor must be completed as part of online registration or turned in prior to going out on the water.

### **6. COURSES:**

6.1 Based on the conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

0900 - Competitors meeting mandatory for all sailors

0930 - First Warning. Races will continue throughout the day.

1500 - No “A” division warning will begin after 1500
