1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, including the ISSA Procedural Rules and the PCISA District Rules.
- 1.2 In accordance with ISSA Procedural Rule 20(b), the right of appeal is denied. Decision for the Protest Committee shall be final.
- 1.3 US Sailing prescription 63.4 is deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to High School sailing teams which meet the eligibility requirements outlined in the PCISA District Rules. It is the intent of the OA to allow a maximum of 64 teams to enter. See PCISA District Rules for details.
- 2.2 Competitors must be accompanied by a designated adult chaperone, who may be an advisor, coach, or parent.
- 2.4 Completed entry forms and the \$220 entry fee which includes the \$60 PCISA sail fee must be submitted before 1700h PDT, Friday 10/25/24. <u>Late entries will not be accepted</u>. <u>No refunds will be issued after the Entry Deadline</u>.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available on Techscore by 0800 11/9/24.

5. FORMAT

- 5.1 The regatta will be sailed in two fleets, Gold and Silver, which will be divided into two divisions, A and B. PCISA reserves the right to assign teams to fleets.
- 5.2 All races will be sailed in a Round Robin format. The number of races will be based on the number of entrants.

6. COURSE

6.1 The racing area will be in the harbor north of the Main Dock of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.

6.2 The course may be any variation of a triangular or other course and may include a leeward gate. Course diagrams will be provided in the sailing instructions.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 Three (3) races for each division will constitute a series.
- 7.2 Scoring will be in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rule 9.
- 7.3 Teams shall be ranked within their fleet, after adding their division series scores, in order of lowest total score first and highest total score last, subject to ISSA Procedural Rules 11(b) & 11(c).

8. COACHING/SPECTATOR BOATS

- 8.1 Coach boats and spectator boats will not be provided. All coaching shall be done ashore on NHYC property.
- 8.2 Spectator boats will stay off the course at all times, and shall have no contact with any competitor who is on the water, except when rendering assistance under RRS 1.1, or as directed by the R/C.
- 8.3 The penalty for failing to comply with these requirements will be dealt with in accordance to the ISSA Procedural Rules.

9. DISCLAIMER

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
