4	ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY
4.1	This event is a MISSA Tier #3 regatta, open to MISSA teams in good standing, 8th-
	12th grades and mixed teams allowed.
4.2	Each Team must register and complete payment online:

4.3	To be considered an entry in the event, teams shall complete the online
	registration requirements by 1159pm Thursday, October 17th, 2024 or until 26 16
	teams have registered, whichever may come first.
5	FEES

- 5.1 Entry fees are as follows: \$65 per sailor. Teams consist of a minimum of 4 sailors and a maximum of 8 sailors.
- 5.2 Fee includes Saturday and Sunday breakfast and lunch for each registered sailor and one coach per team.
- 5.3 A \$250 Damage Deposit check PER TEAM, made out to: White Bear Sailing School, shall be submitted at check-in on Saturday morning. If damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided equally between all the teams competing. Cash will not be accepted

7 Courses

7.1 Courses will be set and sailed in accordance with the recommendations set forth in the ISSA Procedural Rules 2021-2024. Any changes will be noted in the Sailing Instructions.

8 Scoring

- 8.1 A minimum of three races in each division is required for a regatta to be scored.
- 8.2 A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores, in accordance with ISSA PR.

9 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

9.1 Support vessels shall keep clear of racing area and only coach between races

10 RISK STATEMENT

11 RS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

12 PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO RIGHTS

12.1 Competitors give absolute rights and permission for any photographs or video footage taken of themselves or their competing boat to be published in any media whatsoever for editorial, commercial purposes, or to be used in press information.

13 BOATS

- 13.1 WBSS will provide C420s.
- 13.2 Boats shall be sailed as provided.
- 13.3 Teams will rotate boats after each set of races.

14 PARKING

- 14.1 Parking is available at the White Bear Yacht Club parking lot at 56 Dellwood Ave,
 Dellwood MN, 55042. Please do not park in reserved WBYC member spots.
- 14.2 Trailers may be left at the Ramsey County Boat launch or brought back and parked in the northeast corner of the WBYC lot on the grass.
