1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 2021-2024 ISAF RRS, the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association, the ISSA PR's, this NOR, MISSA By-Laws and District Rules, and the Sailing Instructions.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available no later than Friday, September 20th, at 5:00 pm

3 COMMUNICATION

3.1 The online official notice board is located on TechScore.

3.2 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to coaches and support personnel on VHF Channel 69.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 This event is limited to High School Teams only. No 8th graders or mixed teams are eligible to compete. All competitors must be girls.

4.2 Entries must be received by Friday, September 13th by 5 pm.

4.3 Each Team must register online at the regatta page:

4.4 One team is allowed to register per school. The registration is per school. Please list the school name as the "competitor name." Additional sailor details can be entered in RP forms on TechScore.

5 FEES

5.1 Entry fee is \$150 per team

5.2 Lunch is not provided. There will be swag for each sailor and coach.

5.3 All teams must provide a refundable \$400 damage deposit upon registration on Saturday morning in the form of a check or credit card number. In the case that damage cannot be attributed to a single team or specific teams, damage cost will be split amongst all competing teams.

6 SCHEDULE

Saturday, September 21

8:30 a.m. - Arrival 9:15 a.m. - Competitor's meeting 9:45 a.m. - Harbor Launch 10:15 a.m. – First warning signal - if all teams are ready, we will start before this time

Sunday, September 22

8:30 a.m. - Arrival9:15 a.m. - Harbor Launch10:00 a.m. - 420 warning signal - if all teams are ready, we will start before this time No races will be started after 3:00 pm.

7 COURSES

7.1 Courses will be a variation of Windward/Leeward with an offset mark and Leeward Gate as needed. There may be a dog-leg finish.

8 SCORING

8.1 A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores

8.2 There shall be no throw-out races

9 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

9.1 Spectator and support vessels shall keep clear of the race course and only coach from the leeward/starboard side of the starting area.

9.2 Each team/program should have enough support boats for the number of competitors from their club 9.3 All coaches must wear an Engine Cut-Off Switch (ECOS) and a USCG Approved PFD while operating their safety/support boat.

9.4 There will be a large jug for refillable water bottles available on a mark-set boat for sailors and coaches to refill water bottles.

9.5 Rotations will take place on the water if conditions permit. If the race committee deems the conditions too rough to rotate on the lake, rotations will occur just inside the Wilmette Harbor entrance.

10 RISK STATEMENT

10.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, decision to race.

10.2 In consideration for permitting the undersigned participants, skipper and/or boat owner, if different from skipper, to participate in a regatta sponsored by the Sheridan Shore Sailing School and conducted at, adjacent to, and through the facilities of the Wilmette Harbor Association ("WHA") and the Wilmette Harbor Club ("WHC"), each of the undersigned agrees to the following:

10.2(a) I will abide by the rules and regulations of the SSSS, the WHA, and the WHC. 10.2(b) I understand that, because of the nature of sailing, competitive sailboat racing and the "MISSA Girls Qualifier" regatta, there is a risk of physical injury on shore and off shore during the regatta. I hereby release and agree not to sue SSSS, WHA, WHC, Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago ("MWRD"), NSA Properties, Inc. ("NSA"), and their employees, subcontractors, sponsors, agents, affiliates, directors, members (except in their capacity as race competitors), event volunteers, counsel or attorneys (collectively, "Releasees") from all present and future claims that may be made by me, my family, estate, heirs or assigns for property damage, personal injury, or wrongful death arising out of my participation in the regatta, including, but not limited to, claims arising out of or resulting from (1) acts, inactions, equipment, property (including adjacent property) or other facilities of Releasees or any of them, and (2) any acts or inactions by me, my crew or my guests, wherever, whenever, or however the same may occur. 10.2(c) I understand and agree that the Releasees are not responsible for any personal injury or property damage arising out of the regatta, even if caused by their ordinary negligence; provided, however, that I do not release any claims or rights against any competitors in the regatta for any wrongful acts by them, including damage to property or personal injury. I understand that participation in the regatta involves certain risks, including but not limited to serious injury. I, by voluntarily participating in the regatta with knowledge of the danger involved, agree to accept all risks of such participation.

10.2(d) I have read this form and understand by registering for this regatta that I am giving up and releasing rights and remedies.

11 PRIZES

11.1 Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 teams overall, and the 1st place team in each division.

12 PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO RIGHTS

12.1 Competitors give absolute rights and permission for any photographs or video footage taken of themselves or their competing boat to be published in any media whatsoever for editorial, commercial purposes, or to be used in press information.
