#### **Sailing Instructions (SIs)**

#### 1 RULES

1.1 The event is governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028, the prescriptions of US Sailing, ISSA Procedural Rules, MISSA District Rules, the Notice of Race, and these Sailing Instructions.

#### 2 NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- 2.1 Official notices including changes to SIs will be posted on the official notice board online at the <u>scores.hssailing.org</u>, or verbally from the Race Committee Boat.
- 2.2 Changes to the sailing instructions may be made on the water and will take effect immediately.

#### 3 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 3.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed via the race committee boat on the dock.
- 3.2 When the flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

#### 4 SCHEDULE OF RACES

#### 4.1.

#### Saturday, September 20th, 2025

0745: Shuttles to Lighthouse Island (LHI) begin from 19800 Park Ave, Wayzata

0745: Check in and rigging of boats on LHI in the main clubhouse

0845: Coaches meeting

0900: Competitor's meeting

1000: First warning, races to continue throughout the day

#### Sunday, September 21st, 2025

0745: Shuttles to Lighthouse Island begin from Park Avenue

0745: Rigging of boats

0945: Warning signal for first race

1430: No warning signal after this time

\*\*Awards will occur ASAP after racing concludes\*\*

#### 5 BOATS & EQUIPMENT

5.1 If damage to LMSS sailboats or powerboats cannot be attributed to a team or teams, the repair costs will be divided evenly between all teams competing.

#### 6 RACING AREA

6.1 The racing area will be on the open waters of Lake Minnetonka, in the vicinity of Lighthouse Island.

#### 7 COURSES

7.1 The diagram(s) with the course will be available at the competitor's meeting on Saturday morning.

#### 8 MARKS

8.1 Marks will be yellow and orange buoys.

#### 9 THE START

- 9.1 The starting line is between a staff displaying an orange flag on the race committee boat at the starboard end and a yellow ball on the port end of the line.
- 9.2 The starting sequence shall be a 3-minute dinghy start per RRS Appendix U
- 9.3 Code Flag "X" may be displayed for individual recalls. It is the responsibility of the boat to make a proper start. Failure of the Race Committee to make these signals or failure of a starter on the course side to see or hear these signals shall not relieve the offending yacht from restarting and is not grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- 9.4 The start following a General Recall will be run under an I Flag. The I Flag does not need to be flown per ISSA Rules.
- 9.5 A boat that does not start within 3 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.

#### 10 THE FINISH

10.1 The finish line is to the starboard side of the committee boat, and is separate from the starting line.

#### 11 HEARING REQUESTS

11.1 The protest time limit is 30 minutes after the race committee dock time.

Hearing request forms are available in the MYC Clubhouse next to the big smartboard/whiteboard.

#### 12 COACHING

- 12.1 It is the responsibility of the coaches to know the limits of their competitors and pull competitors from racing if conditions exceed their limitations.
- 12.2 Coaches shall stay clear of the racing area unless assisting competitors. Coaching and rotations should take place to leeward and well clear of the start/finish line.

#### 13 RISK STATEMENT

- 13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race.
- 13.2 The OA and the Host will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.




