1. RULES:

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, the prescriptions of US SAILING, the Inter-Scholastic Sailing Association (ISSA) Procedural Rules, the MASSA Procedural Rules, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY:

2.1 Eighteen (18) NJISA teams are invited.

2.2 Teams may register a "second" unofficial team that will not be scored if less than 18 schools sign up for the regatta.

2.3 All competing teams must meet the following requirements: (1) Teams must be members of ISSA, MASSA & NJISA and in good standing including completed registrations and payment of dues.

2.4 Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.

3. ENTRY AND COMMUNICATIONS:

3.1. Schools must also confirm their attendance by email to RWN1Ortho@gmail.com by **Friday, March 28, 2014. @ 9am.**

4 ENTRY FEE: There will be no entry fee.

5 DAMAGE:

5.1 Collisions causing serious damage will be dealt with by jury with regard to RRS rule 14, 68 & 69. 6

6. BOATS:

6.1 Eighteen 420s as supplied by the Ocean County College Sailing.

7 SCHEDULE:

Saturday, March 22, 2014

0830 Check in/registration

0845 Rigging of boats

0915 Skipper's meeting

1000 First warning and schedule for the day

1600 No race will start after this time

7.2 Boats will be-launched out of the Toms River Yacht Club. Rotations will take place on the TRYC dock . Please take your vang's off and remember to step into the cockpit, not on the deck.

7.3 Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board outside the sailing center.

7.4 Race committee may require all sailors wear properly fitting dry / wet suits if conditions warrant.

8 RACING AREA:

8.1 Races will be sailed on the Toms River in front of Toms River Yacht Club.

9 COURSES:

9.1 Based on conditions, the Race Committee will determine the courses as prescribed in ISSA PR 7.7.

10: SCORING:

10.1 The regatta will be scored in accordance with ISSA Procedural Rules.

11 COACHING:

11.1 Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from Saturday to Sunday unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chairperson. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

12 OFFICIAL NOTICE:

12.1 No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chap 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and Intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841. Infringements of this regulation and/or other discipline expectations occurring during November 13-14, 2010 may be the basis for a hearing under RRS 69.1 The protest committee for such a hearing shall be the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA BOD, and the protest committee chairperson. This protest committee shall, at a time and place selected by them, meet to hear said protest, and their decision to impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions they alone deem appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta, shall be final, without appeal.
