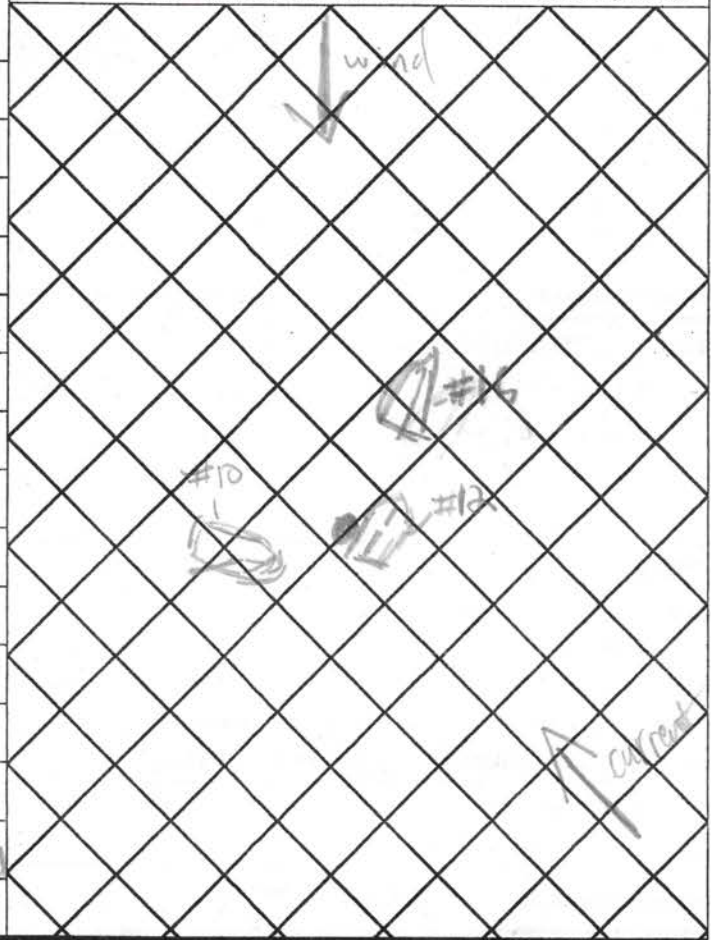

66. - We were never offered the option to have either an expedited procedure or an onshore hearing. According to the SI's, we must be offered the option, but later we were only informed that an expedited procedure

was in order, thus not providing us the opportunity to utilize our witness in the hearing.
