

## Mississippi State High School Team Racing Championship Regatta

### **NOTICE OF RACE**

Host: Bay Waveland Yacht Club March 5-6, 2016

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016 including Appendix D (Team Racing Rules), ISSA Procedural Rules, SEISA Supplemental Rules, this NOR, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 The organizing authority is SEISA, BWYC, and St. Stanislaus.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Competing teams must be current members of ISSA. A team is comprised of at least six sailors who are members of the sailing team for the school they represent. Each team will sail three 420s. High school sailing teams are encouraged to provide their own boats (A limited number of 420s are available from SSC and BWYC--contact Dan Zwerg at dzwerg@ststan.com to coordinate boats). Teams will rotate boats. A school may enter one team only.
- 2.2 Teams representing a school from another state may compete but will be ineligible to win.
- 2.3 Sailors in grades 7-12 are eligible competitors in this regatta.
- 2.4 Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.
- 2.5 Eligible schools and sailors must enter by submitting the official entry form and two separate checks, one for entry fee, and one for boat damage deposit by March 2, 2016.

#### 3. ENTRY FEES

- 3.1 \$60 per team entry fee shall be paid with entry form.
- 3.2 Each team shall pay a separate damage deposit of \$100 with registration. This is refundable if the boat and gear are returned undamaged. In the event damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly amongst all the competing teams.
- 3.3 Lunch is NOT included in the entry fee. Teams may purchase lunches for \$10 per person per day. You may order and pay for lunches at registration.

#### 5. COMPETITOR'S MEETING

5.1 There will be a competitor's meeting on Saturday, March 5<sup>th</sup> inside the yacht club.

#### 6. VENUE

6.1 The sailing venue will be in the Bay of St. Louis.

#### 7. SCORING

- 7.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A of the RRS will apply, except no scores will be discarded.
- 7.2 The number of races intended is two round robins. One completed round shall constitute a regatta.

#### 8. PENALTIES

8.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one jibe, is required.

#### 9. TROPHIES

9.1 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place trophies will be awarded to the top-placing Mississippi teams.

#### 10. SAFETY

10.1 In addition to the requirements of RRS Rule 40 and it's U.S. Sailing Prescription, a condition of entry and participation in this regatta is the wearing of a U.S. Coast Guard approved PFD, properly secured at all times while on the water, except for brief periods while removing or adding clothing. Wet suits, dry suits, buoyancy aids, and inflatable PFD's do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy.

#### 11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 12. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

12.1 Sailing instructions will be available onsite at check-in. The courses to be sailed will be contained in the sailing instructions.

#### 13. SUPPORT AND COACH BOATS

- 13.1 Support and coach boats are explicitly permitted. All personnel are encouraged and expected to render assistance to any boat in need, regardless of team. This is a specific exception to ISSA PR 8(a).
- 13.2 The nearest boat launch for powerboats is at BWYC.

#### 14. BERTHING

14.1 Boats will be berthed on and launched from BWYC.

#### 15. OFFICIAL NOTICE

15.1 No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, marijuana or any other controlled substance, as defined in 21 U.S. Code 802, the possession of which is unlawful under U.S. Code 841, or alcoholic beverages (distilled spirits, wine, and beer, each as defined in Chapter 51of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use). An alleged breach of this procedural rule shall not be grounds for a protest. However, when a report is received from any source, alleging such a breach a protest committee consisting of the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA Board of Directors, and the chairperson of the protest committee, shall follow the process described in RRS 69.1(b). If a hearing under RRS 69 is held, a competitor found to have breached this procedural rule shall be excluded from the remaining races of the series and, where practical, be removed from the regatta venues and sent home. Additional penalties consistent with RRS 69.2 may be imposed on the competitor or the competitor's team. This regulation is in effect during the entire event from the date and time of arrival through the date and time of departure from the regatta site.
