NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020), the prescriptions of US SAILING, the ISSA Procedural Rules (PR), this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. In the event of a conflict between the governing documents and the Sailing Instructions the latter shall take precedence.
- 1.2. RRS Appendix P is in effect as modified per PR 14(c).
- 1.3. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the United States Coast Guard Academy.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. Competing schools must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules, Part III 1, and 5.2.
- 2.2. Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach or parent recognized by the school.
- 2.3. All participants must complete a USCGA Release of Liability Waiver signed by a legal parent or guardian.
- 2.4. Connecticut State Schools will get first preference and remaining slots will be filled accordingly.

- 3.6. NESSA PR Article L (failure to compete) is in effect. No shows at CGA will result in not being asked back.

5. FORMAT

5.1. The regatta will be sailed in two divisions in a single round robin format with one division on the water at a time.

USCGA's fleet of FJ's will be used.

6. RACING AREA

6.1. All races will be sailed on the Thames River in close proximity to the Jacobs Rock Sailing and Seamanship Center.

7. COURSES

7.1. A description of courses will be provided with the Sailing Instructions and will be posted on the Official Notice Board. Courses will be in accordance of PR 7.7.

8. SCORING

8.1. The regatta will be scored in accordance with PR 9 and 11.

9. **BOATS & EQUIPMENT**

9.1. 20 2013 Laser Performance FJs will be provided for all competitors.

9. **COACHING**

9.1. Coaching will be done from shore at the Jacobs Rock Sailing and Seamanship Center. Equal access to coaching will be provided for all teams when time allows between races.

10. WATER AND WATER BOTTLES

10.1. Disposable (single use) water bottles are not allowed. Competitors shall bring their own reusable water bottles. Note that the running water at Jacobs Rock is non-potable. Potable water will be provided in large coolers.
