NOTICE OF RACE

1. REGATTA HOSTS

Treasure Island Sailing Center

Organizing Authority: The San Francisco Yacht Club, in conjunction with Bay Area Youth Sailing

2. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the current ISSA Procedural Rules (as modified by the PCISA District Rules), the NorCal Divisional Regattas Notice of Series, and the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, including the prescriptions of US Sailing.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The online entry form must be completed by **5pm on Friday, March 17**. Entries will not be accepted after this date. Entry fees must be paid in full with the online entry. For online entry go to <http://pcisa.hssailing.org/>

See PCISA District Rule 4.1: Each team will be allowed one 'borrowed sailor' in order to complete a four-person team (A&B Division). This sailor must be an eligible high school sailor registered to another PCISA Team and may sail as a crew only.

See PCISA District Rule 5: Combined teams are allowed in Silver Fleet only, and will be scored as DNFs in their other division. Combined teams shall indicate their intent to be a combined team when registering.

There will be an on-site check-in desk at the regatta, where teams must check in and collect SIs.

4. ENTRY FEES

\$100 per team. **No lunch will be provided.**

5. FORMAT

The Regatta will be sailed in two fleets: Gold Fleet and Silver Fleet. Each fleet shall have an A Division and B Division. Fleet allocations will be approved by the NorCal Allocation Committee after registration closes. The regatta registration limit is 60 teams.

6. BOATS

Each team is responsible for providing one class legal CFJ in excellent condition. Secure hull and tank plugs are mandatory, and teams should have spare parts. Rotation happens only within your team between A and B Divisions. **Boats will not be rotated through the fleet.**

8. COMPETITORS MEETINGS AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SIs)

The competitors' meeting will be held at 1000 Saturday near the hoist area. SIs will be available at check-in.

9. RACING AREA

The Racing Area will be Clipper Cove. Rotations shall be made off the TISC floating docks, unless another area has been designated by the PRO.

10. COACHING

All coaching, crew rotation, exchange of clothing/food/drink and communication shall only occur on docks designated at the competitors' meeting. Coaches are not allowed on the water. Any spectators on the water shall have no contact with any competitor except when rendering assistance under RRS Rule 1.1, or as instructed by the race committee. No persons shall go onto the rocks between the parking lot and the water for any reason whatsoever. This is not a protestable offense, although disciplinary action by the BAYS Board may result, at their discretion.

11. DECISIONS OF THE JURY

Decisions of the jury will be final in accordance with RRS Rule 70.5.

12. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to teams placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each Fleet.

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta.
