Notice of Race

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The Procedural Rules of both ISSA and NESSA shall apply, except as stated below or in the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 All competitors are required to bring their own U.S. Coast Guard Approved lifejackets, bailing buckets, and helmets. A bicycle helmet will suffice as long it has an operable chin strap and is secured while sailing.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to any Massachusetts high school group of students, regardless if they have received prior permission or recognition from their school.
- 2.2 Teams shall consist of at least 4 students who know how to swim, with two students sailing in each of the A and B divisions. .
- 2.3 Entries are to be submitted [electronically](#) by Wednesday, May 23, 2018 at 00:01.
- 2.4 Participation is limited to the first 18 teams that register.
- 2.5 A minimum of 12 teams must register for the event to be held.

3 FEES

The entry fee is \$30 per team. Payments will be collected at the sailing venue in cash or check (payable to "Boston College High School Sailing). Receipts will be available for those who need them.

4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1 Races shall be held on May 23 and 24 in two divisions, with each team sailing in both divisions.
- 4.2 Report time is 13:00 both days. This is the time to show up, NOT the time of the first race.
- 4.3 Racing shall commence shortly after the skippers meeting.
- 4.4 No race shall be started after 17:30.
- 4.5 Three races in both the A and B division shall be completed in order to become an official regatta.

5 BOATS

Club 420s provided by Milton Academy and Boston College High School.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the first day of racing.

7 VENUE

The venue is the Marina Bay between Quincy and UMass Boston.

8 PRIZES

Prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded.
