

Ohio High School Sailing Association Foundry #2 Spring Regatta Saturday, May 8th, 2021 Historic Coast Guard Station Cleveland, OH 44113

NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and will be run in accordance with the Interscholastic Sailing Association Procedural Rules, MISSA District Rules, this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILTY:

Competing teams must be members of MISSA in good standing. A "Team" shall be made up of a minimum of 4 sailors, between the grades of 7-12. This is a Tier 3 event. Mixed teams (comprised of students from different schools) WILL be allowed.

3. BOATS:

- 3.1 13 Club 420 boats shall be sailed as provided by The Foundry. Registration is limited to 13 teams. Class rules do not apply.
- 3.2 Boats will be checked in and out upon launch and haul out. Any previously existing damage should be reported upon launching. Any new damage should be reported between races or upon haul out. All damage is the responsibility of the team(s) sailing the boat.

4. REGATTA FORMAT:

This will be a two-division regatta with no change of boat rotations. Teams will draw for boats at check-in and that will be their A & B division sails the entire regatta.

5. ENTRY:

- 5.1 The entry fee is \$20 per sailor. The fee includes lunch for registered teams and their coach.
- 5.2 Additional lunches for non-competitors may be purchased for \$5.
- 5.3 Registration deadline is 1700 May 6th, 2021

- 5.5 Payment can be made online or offline by presenting a check the morning of the regatta. Checks should be made out to Foundry Sailing Association.
- 5.6 A damage deposit is required in the amount of \$100 per team. Checks should be made out to **Foundry Sailing** and brought to the event.
- 5.7 Foundry waivers for each sailor must be completed as part of online registration.
- 5.8 Drysuits will be required to race.
- 5.9 Masks/Face coverings are required onshore and when on the docks.

0800 - 0900 - Rigging of boats

0900 - Competitors meeting mandatory for all sailors

0945 - First Warning. Races will continue throughout the day.

1530 - No "A" division warning will begin after 1600
