NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the [ISSA Procedural Rules](#) and the [ISSA National Championship General Conditions](#) and [the Scholastic Dinghy Class Rules](#).
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority (OA) is Tabor Academy.
- 1.3. Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, as modified by ISSA Procedural Rule 14(c) will be in effect.
- 1.4. In accordance with RRS 70.5(a), decisions of the protest committee are final. US SAILING's permission has been granted.

- 2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:** The sailing instructions will be posted on Tech Score prior to the report time for the regatta.

- 3. COMMUNICATION:** The online official notice board will be Tech Score.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. Competitors must be members of the Tabor Academy Sailing Team and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.
- 4.2. Selection will be by invitation. The regatta has 18 berths. Allocations will be determined by the Tabor Head Sailing Coach.
- 4.3. Eligible sailors must enter by submitting an official entry form by noon on **Thursday April 28, 2022**. Entry form must include both skipper's and crew's names.

- 4.5. Teams unable to compete must notify the regatta chair as soon as possible.
- 4.6. Host will reallocate vacant district quotas. The first open allocation will go to the host district. A berth becomes vacant when the qualifying district becomes unable to fill the berth.

5. FEES:

The entry is \$0.00 per team

- 6. BOATS:** Z420s as provided by host. Boats will be sailed as provided.

7. SCHEDULE: Saturday, (April 30, 2022)

1000 Check in/registration/Rigging of boats/Sailor's Meeting
First warning and schedule for the day announced at Sailor's meeting
Trophy presentation as soon after racing as possible

Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board.

- 8. RACING AREA:** All races will be sailed Sippican Harbor

9. COACHING:

Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from the start of registration time on Friday until the end of the regatta unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chair. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

10. PRIZES:

The team that finishes first will get their choice from the Swag Bag.

11. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS: By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

12. WAIVER OF LIABILITY: Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
