



Dear MISSA Competitors, Parents, and Coaches;

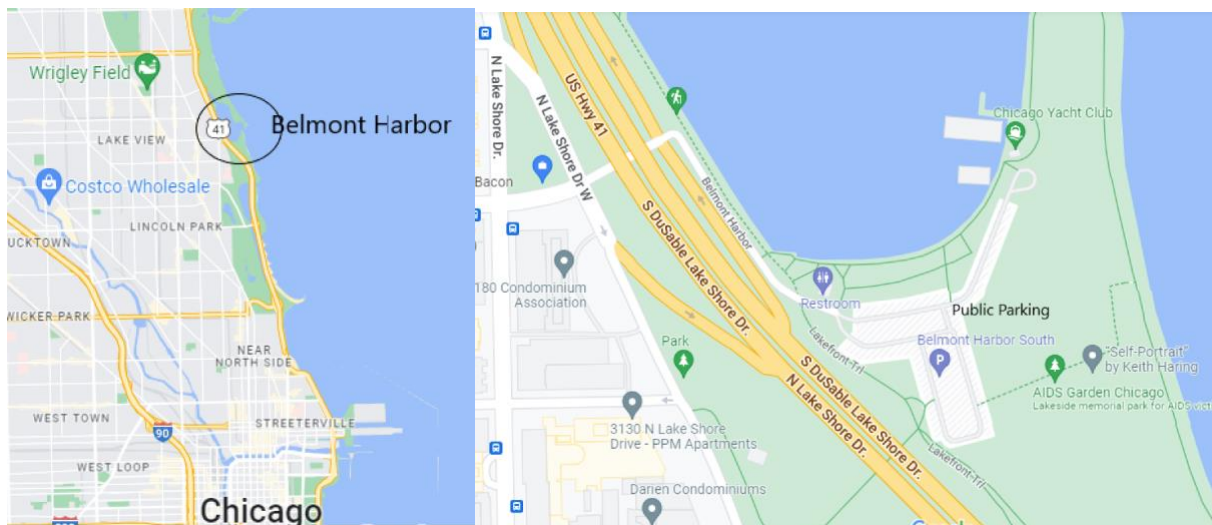
Here are a few additional details for the upcoming MISSA Regatta at Chicago Yacht Club Belmont Station:

WAIVER:

Attached to this email (and posted on the notice board) is the Waiver – it must be printed and signed by the parents/guardian of every sailor. Make sure you bring all Waivers and your \$300 security deposit (per team) to registration on Saturday morning. The Security Deposit Check should be made out to **Chicago Yacht Club**.

LOCATION AND PARKING:

The championship will be sailed at Belmont station this year. The address is 300 W Belmont Ave Chicago, IL 60657. Parking is provided via pay lot, located south of the Boaters Lot/Members lot fee are assessed by the city and fluctuate from time to time. I believe right now, it is \$10.00 for the day.

DRY SUITS:

Per the NOR:

- 12 Due to water temperature, competitors are required:
 1. To provide their own dry suit and have it on hand at the venue on each day of racing as per ISSA PR 2.3.
 2. On each day of racing, the OA will announce at the competitors meeting whether dry suits will be required to be worn by competitors racing on that day.
 3. The combined air temperature and water temperature equal to or exceeding 100 degrees Fahrenheit, will be used by the OA as consideration for not requiring dry suits for the day. Deviation from this guideline is not grounds for redress.
 4. Competitor's failure to wear a dry suit while racing on a day where dry suits are required by the OA will be scored DSQ by the RC without a hearing for every race they were observed sailing without a drysuit. ***This changes RRS 63.1.***

LUNCH:

It is provided for the sailors and coaches, and lunch service will start mid-morning. Race Fans and Parents/guardians may purchase food and beverages at the club using a credit card. If a sailor has food allergies or intolerances, I suggest bringing your own food in this case because the kitchen is not typically open for full menu service this time of year. I'm unsure what types of allergies we could accommodate. I appreciate your understanding in advance.
