NOTICE OF RACE

1. REGATTA ORGANIZING AUTHORITY AND HOSTS

The Pacific Interscholastic Sailing Association (PCISA) is the Organizing Authority
The UC Berkeley Intercollegiate Sailing Team, TISC and Encinal Yacht Club are Hosts.

2. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the ISSA Procedural Rules (as modified by the PCISA District Rules), the *Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of US SAILING (US Sailing prescriptions to rules 60, 63.2, 63.4 are deleted); the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The online entry form must be completed, and entry fee paid, by 5pm PST on February 9, 2024. Late entries will likely not be accepted. Entry fees must be paid in full with the online entry. Entry Fees will not be refundable after the Entry Deadline except under PCISA Rule 8.2. For online entry go to

See PCISA Supplemental Rule 8.2 Regatta Oversubscription: If more than 64 teams register for any PCISA 5 regatta, entries shall be declined in the following order until 64 or less teams are entered: (1) Fourth Teams; (2) Combined Teams (described in District Rule 5); (3) Third Teams; (4) Teams using a "Borrowed Sailor" (described in District Rule 4); (5) Second Teams. Declined entries will be notified as soon as possible after the Entry Deadline via email. The PCISA Board will have final entry authority. The PCISA board may modify the total number of teams at any regatta.

There will be an on-site check-in desk at the regatta, where teams must check in and collect PCISA assigned sails.

4. ENTRY FEES

\$230 per team includes the PCISA sail fees, venue costs, race management and awards. Lunches will NOT be provided this year. Teams are responsible for supplying their own food.

5. FORMAT

The Regatta will be sailed in two fleets - a Gold Fleet and a Silver Fleet. Each fleet will have an A division and a B division. Fleet allocations will be done by PCISA. Regatta limit is 64 teams.

6. BOATS

Each team is responsible for providing one class legal CFJ in excellent condition. Secure hull, centerboard gaskets intact, and tank plugs are mandatory. Teams should have spare parts, even if chartering. All boats will be inspected Saturday morning prior to racing in the event. Each boat is required to use sails issued by the PCISA.

7. CHARTERS

Charter boats will not be provided by the regatta organizers. Teams desiring charters must make arrangements directly with potential providers. Treasure Island Sailing Center (TISC) has charter boats available on a first come, first serve basis. Your first point of contact for charter boats should be Cazzie Cutting at TISC. He is best reached on his cell phone via voice or text.

9. COMPETITORS MEETINGS AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SIs)

Competitors meetings will be held at 1000 Saturday and 0930 on Sunday. SIs will be available online via the PCISA website.

10. RACING AREA

The Racing Area will be in Clipper Cove, with rotations made from the TISC floating dock unless another area has been designated by the PRO. All boats shall be launched from the TISC ramp. Coaches and spectators can view the racing from the shore west of the TISC gate. No persons shall go onto the rocks between the parking lot and the water for any reason whatsoever. This is not a protest able offense, although disciplinary action by the PCISA Board may result, at their discretion.

11. COACHING

All coaching, crew rotation, exchange of clothing/food/drink and communication shall only occur on docks at the TI Sailing Center, or the alternate rotation area designated by the PRO. Coaches are not allowed on the water. Any spectators on the water shall have no contact with any competitor except when rendering assistance under RRS Rule 1.1, or as instructed by the Race Committee.

12. DECISIONS OF THE JURY

Decisions of the jury will be final in accordance with RRS Rule 70.5 and ISSA PR 20

13. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to teams placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each fleet.

14. T-SHIRTS

2024 Golden Bear Regatta Apparel may be provided by the UC Berkeley Sailing Team.

15. DRINKING WATER

Teams are responsible for providing their own water. Competitors who own reusable water bottles are encouraged to bring them along to the regatta.

16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

17. DIRECTIONS to TISC:

Entering "Treasure Island Sailing Center" in Waze/Apple/Google/Maps will only work to get you onto Treasure Island. Due to constantly changing road closures and detours for construction, expect the apps won't work, and you will need to make a large circle around the Island to get to TISC on the end of Clipper Cove. **Please see the map on Appendix A.**

Once you are on Avenue of the Palms with the city of SF to your left and the old Treasure Island municipal / air terminal building on your right (the one you might recognize from Indiana Jones):

- **continue north on Ave of Palms** (with the Bay on your left) **until it ends (likely at 9th Street)**
- make a right on 9th Street, Go as far (EAST) as you can on 9th and make a right (probably Ave M) and then another quick left **to get to Avenue N**
- **make a right on Avenue N** (now heading in a mostly southerly with water on your left again) until it bends to the right and you see the TISC portable buildings.

Parking will be perpendicular to Building 3 or to the fence near the boatyard.
