SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES:

- **1.1.** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the <u>ISSA Procedural Rules</u> and the ISSA National Championship General Conditions and the Scholastic Dinghy Class Rules, and the <u>NESSA District Rules</u>.
- **1.2.** In accordance with RRS 70.5(a), decisions of the protest committee are final. US SAILING's permission has been granted.
- 1.3. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Cape & Island League in conjunction with the hosts.

2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:

- **2.1.** Official notices will be posted on the official notice board located on Tech Score.
- **2.2.** Changes to the sailing instructions shall be posted no later than one half hour prior to the first warning signal on the day it will take effect.
- 3. **CODE OF CONDUCT**: [DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with reasonable request from race officials

4. SCHEDULE:

- 4.1. Report times each day are listed in the NOR.
- 4.2. The number of races each day will be at the discretion of the regatta chair.
- 4.3. Rotation schedules and boat assignments will be posted on Tech Score by the Sailor's meeting.

5. COURSES AND MARKS:

- 5.1. Courses will be in accordance with ISSA PR 7.8
- 5.2. The race committee may designate course selection orally.
- 5.3. All marks will be described at the sailors meeting.

6. START/FINISH AND SIGNALS:

- 6.1. Races will start in accordance with ISSA PR 7.9.
- 6.2. The start/finish line will be between a flag on the race committee boat and a mark.

7. BREAKDOWNS:

- 7.1. Breakdown requests shall be filed in the same manner as protests.
- 7.2. Breakdowns shall be scored in accordance with ISSA PR 9(e). Compensation shall be consistent with ISSA PR Appendix 3.
- 8. PROTESTS: Protests procedure will be in accordance with ISSA PR Part VI
- 9. **SCORING:** Scoring will be in accordance with ISSA PR 9.
- 10. **SAFETY:** A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee either before leaving the course, or if that is impossible, immediately after arriving ashore

11. Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the top school.
