### **NOTICE OF RACE**

(version 03-23-2026)

#### **1. RULES:**

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the [ISSA Procedural Rules](#), the [Scholastic Dinghy Class Rules](#), the [SAISA District Supplemental Rules](#) and Code of Conduct, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions. In the event of a conflict between the governing documents and the Sailing Instructions, the latter shall take precedence.
- 1.2. RRS Appendix P is in effect modified per ISSA PR 13(c).
- 1.3. RRS 60.4(a)(2) is changed as follows: (2) if it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 and is from a boat that was not involved in, **and** did not see, the incident, or”
- 1.4. “In accordance with rule 70.5(a), decisions of the protest committee are final. US Sailing’s permission has been granted.”
- 1.5. The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Interscholastic Sailing Association in conjunction with Charleston Community Sailing.

#### **2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 2.1. The Sailing Instructions will be posted on [TechScore](#) prior to the report time for the regatta.

#### **3. COMMUNICATION:**

- 3.1. The online official notice board will be [TechScore](#).
- 3.2. General event information and entry list can be found on [ClubSpot](#).

#### **4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:**

- 4.1. Competing schools must be members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules.
- 4.2. Teams must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader, who may be an advisor, coach, or parent recognized by the school. The adult leader must have the authority to authorize medical care for all sailors on their team.

- 4.3. The regatta has up to 16 berths. Allocations will be determined by the 2025-2026 scores of the North/South Points Series, as well as the Caribbean Championship. One additional at-large berth may also be available and will be allocated by the Executive Committee of the SAISA Board of Directors.
- 4.4. Eligible schools must enter by submitting an official entry form on [ClubSpot](#) by 5:00PM on April 6, 2026. When registering, please fill in the 'Skipper Details' section with the name of the school as the 'First Name' and leave 'Last Name' blank. Crew and boat information should be left blank. An email will be sent verifying registration completion.
- 4.5. Teams unable to compete must notify the regatta chairperson as soon as possible and no later than the registration deadline.
- 4.6. SAISA will reallocate vacant berths.

## 5. FEES:

- 5.1. The entry is \$200 per team.
- 5.2. The entry fee can be paid at the end of registration on [ClubSpot](#) by credit card, debit card, or bank information.
- 5.3. A damage deposit of \$500 must be submitted during check in on Friday, April 10, 2026 or Saturday, April 11, 2026. This will be returned/refunded if the boat and gear are returned undamaged. In the event damage cannot be attributed to a particular team, the repair costs will be divided evenly amongst all competing teams.
- 5.4. Checks should be made payable to Charleston Community Sailing, Inc.

## 6. BOATS:

- 6.1. Sixteen collegiate 420s will be provided by Charleston Community Sailing and Carolina Yacht Club. Boats will be sailed as provided.

- 7.1. Parking in the Carolina Yacht Club lot will be limited to one car per team. After the first car from a team is admitted, no additional cars from that team will be allowed to park on site. Please make arrangements to carpool. Limited parking is available on the water side of [East Battery Street](#) for free. Additional paid parking options are listed on the [Charleston City Parking Information Page](#).
- 7.2. Changes to the schedule will be posted on the official notice board on [TechScore](#).

## 8. RACING AREA:

- 8.1. All races will be sailed off the docks at the Carolina Yacht Club.
- 8.2. Boats 1-13 will be sailed back to the [Charleston Community Sailing dock](#) at the Safe Harbor Charleston City marina when racing concludes.

**9. COACHING:**

9.1. Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors, and other support personnel shall not go afloat in the sailing area from 3:00PM on Friday until after racing has ended on Sunday unless explicitly permitted by the regatta chairperson. The penalty for failing to comply with this requirement may be the disqualification of all boats, competitors, and teams associated with the infringing support personnel.

**10. PRIZES:**

10.1. Prizes will be awarded to schools placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in the overall standings.

**11. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS:**

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

**12. WAIVER OF LIABILITY:**

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.

The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
